



Supplementary Regulations FIM Europe European Cross Country Cup 36/02 28/05 2022 SML Lahti/FIN ASIKKALA CROSS COUNTRY 2022 (ACC 2022)

1. General

The competition is held in accordance with the FIM Europe Sporting Code and FIM Europe Regulations for the European Cross-Country Cup and this Supplementary Regulations that has been approved by the FIM Europe.

The competition will take place Saturday the 28th of May 2022 at Vesivehmaa airport, 20 km north from Lahti. 61°08'53.5"N and 25°41'20.8"E.

6. Entry fee

The entry fee is 80 Eur for all classes

7. Competitors

All the riders must hold a valid FIM/FIM Europe or National Enduro/Motocross license and have a starting permit from his/her National Federation (FMNR). Further on the rider has to have an insurance confirmed by his/her FMN and be a minimum age of 15 years.

RACE CONDITIONS

9. Course

The Competition is a Cross Country Enduro on a marked circuit, lap distance 20 km. Quad class 10 km

Estimated time for one lap is 22 min, Quad class 15 min.

In all classes, the running time is 3 hours, except class ATV Quad 2×4 & 4×4 1,5 hours

The race is finished after 3 hours (ATV Quad 1,5 hours) regardless of where the leader is on the track.

The average speed is ca. 40 km/hrs.

Time limit

All riders have to finish the race no later than 60 min after that the overall winner has passed the finish line in order to complete the race. If the race continues for 3 hrs (Quad 1,5 hrs). all riders have to pass the finish line no later than 3,5 hrs. (Quad 2 hrs.) after the start of the race.

The organizer reserves the right of changing the number of laps and the length of the circuit depending on the actual conditions on the day of the competition.

10. Administrative Control

Race Office will be open on Friday the 27th from 16.00 to 20.00 and on Saturday the 28th from 06.00 to 16.00 p.m. At the administrative inspection the rider must submit his/her FIM, FIM Europe or National Rider's Licence, confirmation of entry fee payment, filled entry form and starting permission from FMNs confirming insurance.

11. Technical Inspection

After the Administrative Control every rider directly should move on to the Technical Inspection. The Technical Inspection will be open on Friday the 27th from 16.00 to 20.00 and on Saturday the 27th from 06.00 to 16.30 p.m.

It is allowed to use off road (MX) tyres.

12. Environment

It's mandatory to use an Environmental Mat in the Pit area. Team not equipped with an Environmental Mat will not be allowed to enter the Pit area. Rider who are assisted or have the bike refilled outside the Pit area will be disqualified. Every competitor service car must have fire extinguisher.

Using of tear-offs is forbidden.

About 300 m from the Pit area there is a clearly marked recycling station area there competitors could leave hazardous material such as oil, tyres, battery etc.

13. Prizes and Prize Giving Ceremony

Prize giving ceremony will be at track after each start, 1 and 15 minutes after running time

14. Results

The official results will be put up at the Information Board outside the office Tent as soon as the time for protest is ended, 30 min after the arrival of the last rider in each class. The result will also be published on <https://live.kalkku.fi/>

15. Start

All starts will be conducted with stopped engine.

Groups and starting times will be clarified in PM by mail or at official board.

16. Equipment

Riders, their bikes and protection clothing should comply with FIM Europe Regulations. Tear offs is forbidden.
